Meeting called to order at 6:35pm by Paul Wong.

The Minutes from the January 12th, 2010 meeting were reviewed via email prior to the meeting. Motion by Christy Liekhus, seconded by Natalie Pohl to approve the minutes. All in favor; motion passed.

- Player Registration
 - Discussion on the number of players who have signed up (not paid), who have signed up and paid, and those who have said they are playing, but have not registered or paid.
 - Lynn Rogers has a list of all players, separated by their registration status. List was reviewed by all. Drew, Natalie, and Lynn will contact players who need to complete registration process.
 - We currently have 35 players who should be playing this season. There will be one Varsity team and one Jr. Varsity team to be determined by the coaches.
 - Discussion on number of possible scholarships that will be needed. It was determined that all players who have not yet paid will receive a letter via email as well as regular mail (to be handed out at practice), letting them know when their payments are due. On February 26th and March 15th equal payments of

\$225 will be due. In addition, a \$15 spirit pack payment is due immediately. A letter will be drafted from the Treasurers to go out ASAP, and will also be signed by the President.

- Players who cannot make full payments will be given options to fundraise for their fees. Possibilities include working snack bar at TELL Baseball field, selling banners to local businesses, etc..
- Players needing to borrow Varsity helmets will be issued them at the game. They will be returned at the end of each game to the equipment manager.

- Game Schedule

- Discussion on game dates: The Senior game will be on April 21st and the Blue Cru game will be on March 31st. Christy Liekhus is in charge of the Senior Recognition game. Lynn Rogers and Laura Thornton offered to help. Other volunteers will also be needed. Paul Wong will contact Mitchell Krause to organize the Blu Cru game.
- Discussion on game schedule and possible conflicts: April 2nd is a holiday so game vs. Esperanza needs to be rescheduled. Game vs. Santa Margarita has multiple conflicts. Drew will work with Lance Neal on all scheduling conflicts.

Old Business

- Lights will no longer be needed due to earlier practice times.
- There is \$175 in our ASB account. We will use this money to purchase the 3 additional stick bags needed.
- Pennies have been delivered; however, we will continue to use the practice pennies Drew and Trent have until we can confirm player payments.
- Drew stated we have approximately 9 blue and 6 white shorts left over from last season. Paul has the new shorts (45 white and 45 blue).
- Helmets: Paul will find the 3 loaner helmets that are currently being used.

New Business

- Practice is from 3:30-5:30pm Monday through Friday. On Tuesday and Thursday the boys are to report to the weight room for a light warm up lifting session from 2:45pm to 3:15pm. If games are scheduled on Tuesday or Thursday, weightlifting will be moved to Monday and Wednesday.
 - Off Campus Passes: Drew is working with Lance Neal and Sissy Oberlin to obtain passes. Players must have completed all necessary paperwork and paid their transportation fees to obtain passes.
 - Mr. Bowman has the team clock, score cards and other game day equipment. Since games are now at Beckman, Drew will check with Mr. Galloway about keeping the equipment and setting it up on game days.
